Linden Park is awarded AIA Baltimore's 2017 Excellence in Design Awards Honorable Mention and Good Design = Good Business Honorable Mention





On October 13th, 2017, Linden Park Apartments was awarded Honorable Mention for the 2017 Excellence in Design Award as well as Honorable Mention for the Good Design = Good Business Award at AIA Baltimore's 2017 award ceremony. The awards highlighted Linden Park's redevelopment team of Somerset Memorial Partners, Wiencek + Associates, and Hamel Builders.

The renovations of Linden Park Apartments, completed in 2016, transformed an obsolete 1967 highrise in Baltimore to preserve affordable housing for seniors. The redevelopment acted as a catalyst in the neighborhood by restoring critical functionality to meet the needs of the residents and the surrounding neighborhood.

Originally built as one of the earliest HUD 202-financed projects in the country, the project suffered from years of neglect and was left un-renovated until 2014. The architect, Wiencek + Associates, devised a modern design that provided a renewed exterior facade by introducing floor-to-ceiling windows at the end of the building, along with enclosing the under building driveway to create a new leasing office, wellness suite and salon. The building was completely transformed to a safe, healthy, energy efficient and amenity-rich community with Universal Design standards. Once a liability, Linden Park is again a thriving community that allows senior residents to age in place in the neighborhood they call home.
